
Pirate Dress Code



ACROSS

- 1. Used to protect feet mostly while on land
- 3. A heavy woolen fabric
- 4. A sash made of fine fabric
- 5. A sign of wealth, thought to help with sea sickness
- 8. Tight fitting pants
- 10. A woolen cap
- 12. Favored by pirate captains, these head coverings were usually stolen
- 14. A sleeveless coat once called a jerkin
- 17. Jewelry made of gold, silver, jewels, and pearls
- 18. Bright mismatched pattern and colored clothing
- 19. This item kept sweat out of a pirate's eyes
- 20. Trousers usually worn by English pirates

DOWN

- 1. A pistol holder
- 2. A hat with three edges, usually made of leather
- 6. Jewery worn on the hands
- 7. Blackbeard is said to have tied black ones of these to his beard
- 9. Leg coverings made of wool
- 11. Expensive decorated coats worn on land
- 13. A puffy sleeved garment usually worn on land
- 15. A heavy curves fighting sword
- 16. Also known as a cutlass
